PURPOSE: Cub Crafters, Inc. has determined that there is the

possibility that the pilot's clothing may snag the fuel selector handle and move it inadvertently. This Service Bulletin provides instructions to prevent this from occurring and to replace the handle with a new one which precludes the possibility of inadvertent

operation.

INSTRUCTIONS: PART A

 Insert page number 4-11A after page 4-11, in section 4 of the Aircraft Flight Manual and Pilot Operating Handbook, document TC10000AFM. (See Figure 1)

2. Make note in aircraft log book that Service Bulletin SB0006 Part A has been complied with.

WARNING

PRIOR TO ANY FLIGHT, ENSURE THAT THERE IS NO POSSIBILITY OF THE PILOT'S SLEEVE FROM GETTING CAUGHT ON THE FUEL SELECTOR HANDLE, ESPECIALLY WHEN OPERATING THE FLAPS. WEAR SHORT SLEEVE SHIRTS OR TIGHTLY FITTING SLEEVES.

- 1. Remove fuel selector TC7013-001 by unscrewing the screw on the shaft of the handle.
- 2. Discard part number TC7013-001.




Figure 2 - Fuel Selector Handle TC7013-003




Figure 3 - Fuel Handle Installation

- 3. Install new fuel selector handle TC7013-003 by screwing it onto the shaft. (Figure 2 and Figure 3)
- 4. Rotate handle through all the positions and ensure that the detents are clearly felt when each tank position (LEFT, BOTH, RIGHT) are selected.
